

Pattern fir cone (Tannzapfen)

2 inches (5,5cm)



material:

100% cotton yarn, 50g pro ball,
125m / 136 yards per ball

steel crochet hook size:

metric: 1,5mm, US: 8, UK: 4 1/2

abbreviation:

st= stitch

sc= single crochet

slst= slip stitch

ch= chain

pr= previous round

dc= double crochet

tr= treble crochet

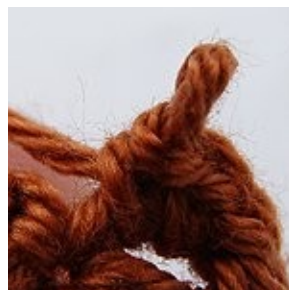

Part 1 (make 2)



Round 1:

make 6sc in a crochet ring (6 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 2:

turn the work and crochet a ch
work 2 sc in each st around (12 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 3:

turn the work:
*3 ch, in the first stitch: 1tr, 1dc, then
make on the dc 2 sc (**image 1-3**)
and work one sc in the same stitchhole
(**image 4**).

In stitch 2 and 3 make 1 slst.*

from now on repeat from * to * 3 times

finish:

sew up the end of yarn neatly

Part 2 (make 3)



Round 1:

make 6sc in a crochet ring (6 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 2:

turn the work and crochet a ch
work 2 sc in each st around (12 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 3:

turn the work and crochet a ch
work 2 sc in each 2th st around (18 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 4:

turn the work:

*3 ch, in the first stitch: 1tr, 1dc, then
make on the dc 2 sc (**image 1-3**)
and work one sc in the same stitchhole
(**image 4**).

In stitch 2 and 3 make 1 slst.*

from now on repeat from * to * 5 times

finish:

sew up the end of yarn neatly

Part 3 (make 6)



Round 1:

make 6sc in a crochet ring (6 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 2:

turn the work and crochet a ch
work 2 sc in each st around (12 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 3:

turn the work and crochet a ch
work 2 sc in each 2th st around (18 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 4:

turn the work and crochet a ch
work 2 sc in each 3th st around (24 sts)
with a slst join the round

Round 4:

turn the work:

*3 ch, in the first stitch: 1tr, 1dc, then
make on the dc 2 sc (**image 1-3**)
and work one sc in the same stitchhole
(**image 4**).

In stitch 2 and 3 make 1 slst.*

from now on repeat from * to * 7 times

finish:

sew up the end of yarn neatly

bond the fire cone:

Pile all parts, begin from below:

1 x part 2,

6 x part 3,

2 x part 2,

2 x part 1,

top from fir cone

with the yarnends from the top fir cone
(we leaved longer) put throug all parts.

Tie it together, knot the yarnends and
neatly sew them up.

top from fir cone:

**leave 40 inches of yarn and start
working at this point**

*5 ch, 1sc in every ch from second ch
from hook (4ch)*

from now on repeat from * to * 2 times

with a slst join the round

Let the end of the yarn a bit longer,
because later it`s needed.
